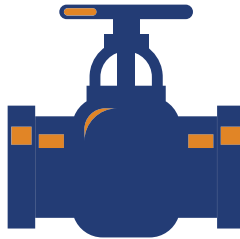

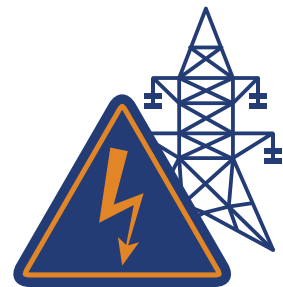

Clinical Medical Assistant

Orleans Technical College 25-week in-person and 5-week externship program will train you for a health care career. Clinical Medical Assistants work in a variety of health settings, including: doctor's offices, clinics, and hospitals.

Our program combines classroom education, hands-on practical assignments, and an externship with employer partners. Dedicated staff help every step of the way, from application and financial aid eligibility to successful program completion and certification – plus employer connection to jobs. Successful students will be prepared to sit for the national NHA CCMA credential.

Our skills lab is equipped with medical equipment used in a professional healthcare setting.

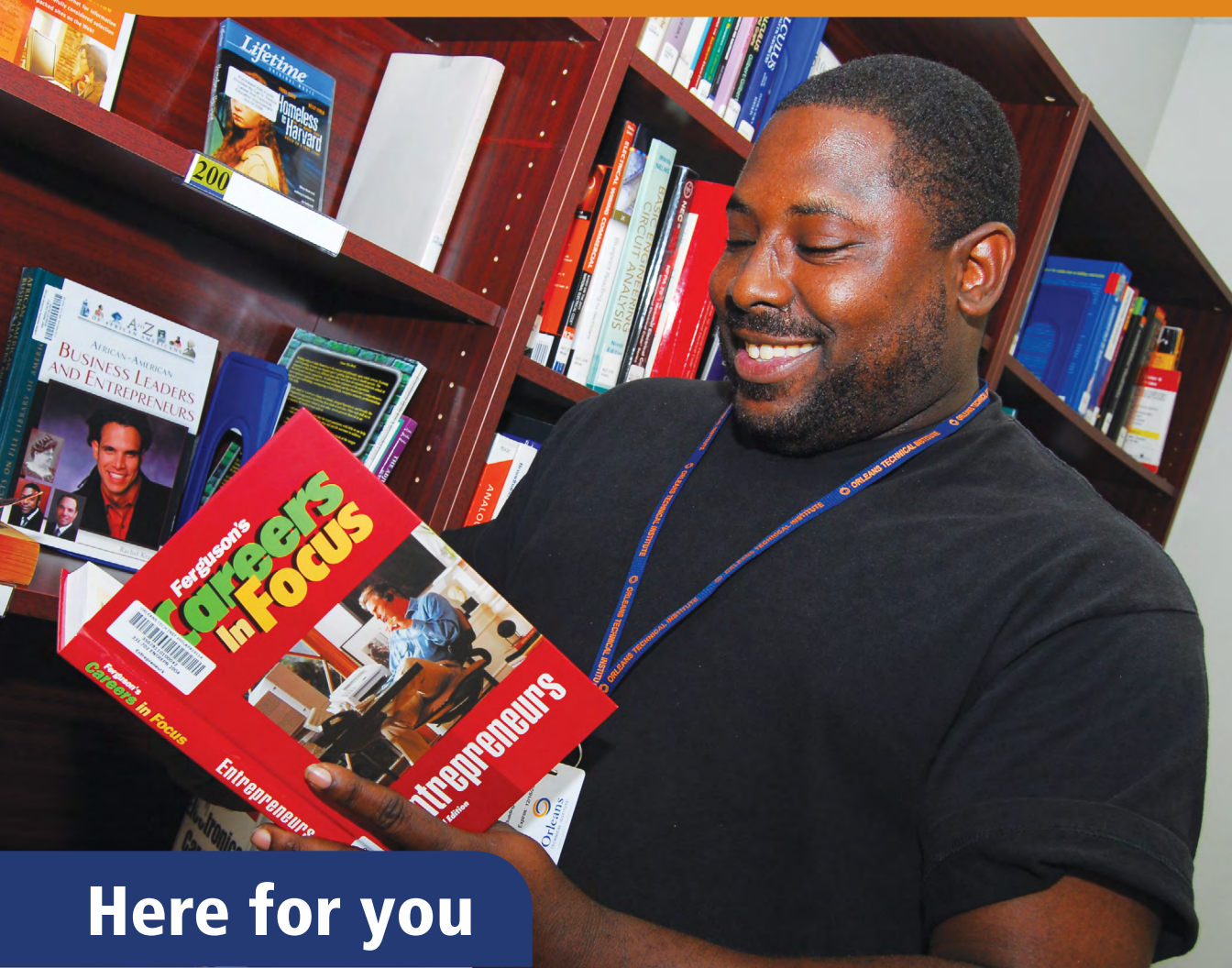
Paying for School
